HB 95	<b>HEALTH- EASY ENROLLMENT ACT</b> House Bill 95 (HB 95) relates to health. HB 95 enacts the Easy Enrollment Act. HB 95 establishes the Easy Enrollment Program. HB 95 requires revision of state income tax forms to allow taxpayers to consent to provision of certain information pertaining to enrollment in certain health coverage programs. HB 95 allows the Human Services Department to enroll consenting taxpayers in Medicaid. HB 95 allows the New Mexico Health Insurance Exchange to enroll consenting taxpayers in qualified health plans under certain circumstances. HB 95 provides an exception to confidentiality for certain tax return information.
