

How to Request Official Motor Vehicle Evaluation for Patient

If you feel there is a person you know that may be a driving hazard to themselves and others you can notify the NM Motor Vehicle Division of your concern by letter. This letter is fully confidential and in no way will be shared with anyone including the person the letter was sent for. The letter can be mailed or faxed to the address and fax number below. In this letter, provide as much of the person's information as possible (full name, driver's license number if possible, date of birth, SSN if possible and the mailing address). Once the letter is received, a temporary hold is put on the driver and a letter is sent requesting them to do three things (medical exam, eye exam and skills test with a MVD tester). If the customer does not comply in the time given, their license will be canceled and not be issued again. If they do comply but fail any of the three exams/screenings, their license will be canceled and denied renewal. If they happen to pass and get cleared to drive, they are allowed to continue driving and able to renew the license.
