



Speakers



Susan R. Bailey MD

Dr. Bailey was re-elected Speaker of the American Medical Association House of Delegates at its June 2016 annual meeting. She previously served as AMA vice speaker, chair of the AMA Council on Medical Education, the AMA's representative to the Assembly of the American Board of Medical Specialties, and the AMA nominee to the board of directors for the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education. She is a tenacious advocate for physicians and their patients and has been actively involved with organized medicine for all of her professional career. At the state level, she served as president of the Texas Medical Association (TMA), speaker and vice speaker of the TMA House of Delegates, and chaired the Texas delegation to the AMA. Dr. Bailey is an allergist in private practice in Ft Worth, Texas.



David Bear PhD

Dr. Bear is Research Professor of Cellular and Molecular Medicine at the University of Arizona College of Medicine, and Professor Emeritus of Cell Biology and Physiology at the UNM School of Medicine. He received a PhD in chemistry from the University of California at Santa Cruz and was a NIH Postdoctoral Fellow at the University of Oregon Institute of Molecular Biology. He joined the UNM SOM faculty in 1982, and has served as Director of Graduate Studies, Chair of Cell Biology and Physiology, Associate Dean for Admissions, and Chair of Chemistry and Chemical Biology. His research focuses on the molecular genetics of muscle cell diseases and new approaches to medical education in genetics and genomics. Dr. Bear directs the course in genetics for first-year UNM medical students.



Karissa Culbreath PhD

Dr. Culbreath is Assistant Professor in the Department of Pathology and Scientific Director of the Infectious Disease Department at TriCore Reference Laboratories. Dr. Culbreath received her PhD from Vanderbilt University and completed a fellowship in Medical and Public Health Microbiology at University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. She is board-certified by the American Board of Medical Microbiology. Dr Culbreath's research interests include determining clinical outcomes for emerging technologies and development of diagnostic algorithms to decrease cost and increase efficiency in the clinical laboratory.

Annette Fontaine MD, MBA

Dr. Fontaine graduated from Ross University Medical School and continued her education in medicine at the University of West Virginia in Morgantown where she completed her residency in Internal Medicine and fellowship in Hematology/Oncology. Dr. Fontaine joined the New Mexico Cancer Center in 2006 and practices at the main site in Albuquerque and also at a satellite clinic in Silver City. Her curiosity in the relationship of genetics and cancer lead her to specialized training at the City of Hope, earning a certificate in Cancer Genetics. She has a keen interest in the business of medicine and hence earned a physician executive MBA from the University of Tennessee. Dr. Fontaine was appointed as Chief Medical Officer allowing her to work on the development of clinical pathways in the management of cancer among other duties.



John Maynard

Mr. Maynard is a serial entrepreneur and engineer with over 20 years of experience developing diagnostic medical devices for a diversity of applications including a urea breath test for detection of certain types of bacterial pneumonia, automated reading of retinal photographs to detect eye disease, noninvasive screening for diabetes, and noninvasive measurement of glucose. A common thread through these applications is the use of optical measurements, signal processing and sophisticated data mining techniques for detection and monitoring of disease.



Katie Mowry PhD

Dr. Mowry is the Director of Research and Development for NuTech Medical and responsible for the clinical and preclinical research activities. She received her Bachelors degree in biological engineering from Mississippi State University and went on to complete her Doctoral degree at the University of Alabama at Birmingham in biomedical engineering with a focus on functionalizing biomaterials with bioactive components for bone healing. Dr. Mowry's current research focus is amniotic tissue as a platform for regenerative medicine — areas of interest include bone, tendon, wound, cartilage and inflammatory diseases.
